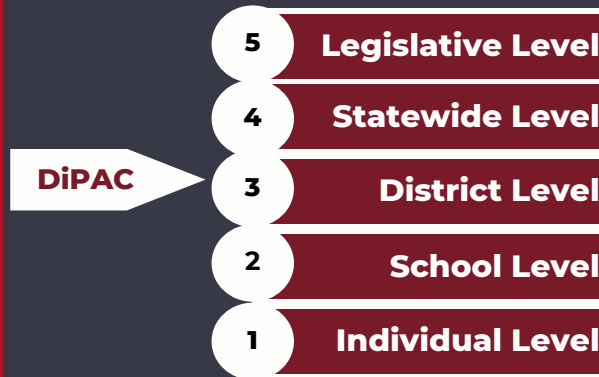


We are the **parent voice** working collaboratively with school administration to enhance students' educational experience, support their academic success, and meet their social & emotional needs.

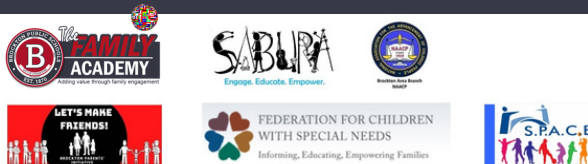
Our Advocacy
